SENTENCE PRISON

Based on the defendant's conviction of ATTEMPTED MURDER WITH INJURY a 1st Degree Felony, the defendant is sentenced to an indeterminate term of not less than three years and which may be life in the Utah State Prison.

Based on the defendant's conviction of FORCIBLE SEXUAL ABUSE a 2nd Degree Felony, the defendant is sentenced to an indeterminate term of not less than one year nor more than fifteen years in the Utah State Prison.

COMMITMENT is to begin immediately.

To the UTAH County Sheriff: The defendant is remanded to your custody for transportation to the Utah State Prison where the defendant will be confined.

SENTENCE PRISON CONCURRENT/CONSECUTIVE NOTE

The prison terms are concurrent to each other.

SENTENCE RECOMMENDATION NOTE

The Court recommends that the Board of Pardons take into account the time defendant has served in jail since his arrest.
